TECHNOLOGY: V.I.O. to make Army gear

Marquette-based V.I.O. Inc., an innovator of hands-free video technology, has received funding with the U.S. Army Research Laboratory to research and develop wearable video technology for military and law enforcement use. As part of a multiyear agreement with the U.S. Army, V.I.O. received first-year funding of \$862,000. V.I.O. will contract with Michigan Technological University to help with the development of video electronics that will increase the ability of the military to see and record the battlefield.
